The management of Parkwest Air Tours, Inc. reserves the right to assign additional dual flight time to anyone observed acting in a negligent manner in regard to safe flight procedures. In signing this agreement, each pilot hereby agrees to the following:

Airworthiness:

Aircraft procured by Parkwest Air Tours, Inc. for client use are supplied by flight schools, air charter companies, flying clubs, private individuals and other institutions and air charter companies. The aircraft are maintained according to United States regulations governing aircraft that are used for rental purposes. Exterior paint and interior condition may vary. However, Parkwest Air Tours, Inc. makes no representation nor warranty, express or implied, about the airworthiness, or other condition of the aircraft, its engine, its mechanical and/or electrical components, avionics, or airframe. It is the responsibility of the Client/Pilot, acting in his or her capacity as Pilot-In-Command (PIC), to determine the airworthiness of the aircraft supplied.

Navigation:

For the purpose of navigational assistance on its tours, Parkwest Air Tours provides each Client/Pilot with a pre-planned route of flight, suggested altitudes, and a pre-programmed GPS unit. The Client/Pilot, as Pilot In Command, agrees that these tools are for his/her navigational assistance only, and at no time should be considered reliable or obligatory in any way. Each Client/Pilot is encouraged to verify any information provided by Parkwest in terms of aircraft navigation, airspace rules, aircraft performance, and airport information.

Rules and Regulations:

The Client/Pilot accepts the following rules and regulations that are made to safeguard him or her, passengers, and the aircraft. Client/Pilot agrees:

1. To inform him/herself about the tour, airspace, and airports involved in the tour, and to attend the Parkwest pre-tour briefing in Grand Junction and each and every pre-flight meeting while on the tour.
2. To read and familiarize him/herself with the appropriate Pilot Operating Handbook for the aircraft being flown.
3. To **not** operate the aircraft if impaired from illness, drugs or alcohol.
4. To **not** smoke in or near the aircraft at any time.
5. To use the aircraft for the purpose and over the route specified.
6. To personally check the general airworthiness of the aircraft and the proper operation of all its related accessories, and to personally check that the fuel tanks contain sufficient fuel for the contemplated flight, that the oil is at the proper level, and that the caps on the fuel and oil tanks are secure.
7. To drain the gascolators before each flight.
8. To operate the aircraft in strict compliance with all applicable rules and regulations of the Federal Aviation Administration.
9. To obtain weather reports and forecasts immediately before each flight, and to **not** fly when ceilings or visibility are forecast to go below VFR minimums or when surface winds or gusts are excessive, and, in no case, to exceed his or her piloting experience and ability.
10. To permit no one else to pilot the aircraft except a duly authorized pilot checked and approved by Parkwest Air Tours, Inc.

11. To land only at established airports, except in an emergency or as a precautionary measure.
12. To keep all doors and windows of the aircraft closed and locked at all times when the aircraft is in flight.
13. To personally see that the aircraft is properly and securely tied down at all times when the aircraft is not in flight.
14. To notify Parkwest Air Tours, Inc. of any malfunction of the aircraft, engine, instruments, or equipment.
15. Unless prevented by circumstances occurring without his or her fault and beyond his or her control, to return the aircraft to Parkwest Air Tours, Inc. within the time scheduled for his or her use of the aircraft. If return of the aircraft or payment on the contract will be delayed beyond the scheduled time for any reason, the Client/Pilot is to notify PARKWEST AIR TOURS, INC. by telephone as soon as possible.
16. To comply with all reasonable requests regarding proper entries on flight sheets, log books, or other reports in a complete, neat, and legible manner.
17. To operate and treat the aircraft in a conservative and careful manner and to return it in undamaged condition.
18. To **not** fly the aircraft between sunset and sunrise without prior approval of Parkest Air Tours, Inc.
19. To **not** fly the aircraft in any manner that requires a special permit or waiver from the Federal Aviation Administration.
20. To **not** to fly the aircraft in violation of the Client's pilot certificate or in violation of the airworthiness certificate of the aircraft.
21. Except when necessary for landings and take-offs, to **not** fly the aircraft at an altitude of less than 500 feet AGL nor below the minimum safe altitude of flight prescribed by the Federal Aviation Administration.
22. To **not** fly or attempt to fly the aircraft in aerobatic flight; to **not** fly the aircraft in closed-course racing, or in connection with hunting, herding, or other extraordinary activity.
23. **Not** to instruct others in the operation of the aircraft nor operate the aircraft for personal instruction, except when given by a qualified instructor.
24. **Not** to operate the aircraft in any manner outside the coverage afforded by the liability insurance obtained by Parkwest Air Tours, Inc. Renter's insurance is recommended to cover renter against the insurance deductible.

I certify that:

- A. All statements made by me on this rental agreement are true and correct,
- B. All pilot and medical certificates presented by me in connection with this agreement are valid and belong to me, and
- C. I will never attempt to operate any of the aircraft provided by Parkwest Air Tours, Inc. under any pilot or medical certificate that is in a revoked, suspended, or expired status.
